One of these products, Camino, has been in a pilot stage with 5 of our parishes and has had great success. It is with this in mind that I endorse Camino as a good and prudent database product for the parishes within our Diocese. Within the next few weeks or months a representative from Diocesan, a Catholic communications company that has built Camino, will be in touch to see if you would like to take advantage of this database solution. Camino offers a Catholic approach to parish database management and comes with great features such as online faith formation and tracking, the ability for parishioners to update their profile right from their phone, easy and quick reporting, and the ability to communicate with parishioners. I truly believe that this product can be of significant aid to the parishes.

Due to our relationship and the positive feedback from the pilot, Diocesan has been kind enough to cut the cost of the one-time conversion fee for anyone that switches over to Camino within the Diocese. Switching is easy and their Customer Care team will handle 95% of the conversion at a discounted rate of \$750. After this one-time fee, parishes can enjoy the use of Camino for \$125 a month.
