HOW TO GO TO CONFESSION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation



0 PRAY & REFLECT

Before entering the confessional, pray that God will help you make a good confession. Consider using an **EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE**.



1 SIGN OF THE CROSS

Place yourself in the presence of God, **"in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."** The priest may greet you or offer a blessing.



2 CONFESS YOUR SINS

A necessary element is to confess your sins, **to say aloud for what you are sorry**, to a priest who listens lovingly on behalf of Christ and his Church.



3 RECEIVE PENANCE

The minister will offer guidance and **assign prayers or good deeds**, so that you may begin the path of healing in your relationships.



4 ACT OF CONTRITION

"My God, **I am sorry** for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen."



5 RECEIVE ABSOLUTION

The priest will bless you in the person of Christ, who **frees you from sin**.
