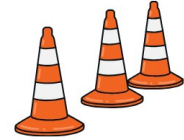
As part of the Growing Our Legacy of Faith campaign there will be road construction on 11th Ave, Mallory St., and 12th Ave.

WELCOME, FATHER SEAN KNOX!

Fr. Sean Knox returned to the Diocese after serving as the Parochial Vicar at Blessed Sacrament, Tallahassee. He grew up in the in Homestead, Fl where he and his family attended Sacred Heart Catholic Church. After high school in 1984, he entered the United States Air Force (USAF) as a Tactical Aircraft Mechanic in 1985 and served a total of 8 years. It was while at his last duty station, Eglin AFB, Ft Walton he left the Air Force in August 1992, and entered the seminary for the Diocese of Pensacola/Tallahassee.



After attending St. Joseph Abbey and Seminary College in Covington, LA and St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton Beach, he was ordained a priest in 2001. His first parish assignment was St. Ann, Gulf Breeze and Our Lady of the Assumption, Pensacola Beach (2001-2005). From there he was named as the pastor for St Anne, Marianna and St Joseph the Worker, Chipley (2005-2010). He was then given permission by Bishop John Ricard to re-enter the USAF as a Chaplain. He served briefly at St. Dominic's, in Panama City to prepare for re-entry into the USAF, where he served as a Chaplain (2010-2023). He retired from the USAF in March 2023 and returned to the Diocese to serve at Blessed Sacrament Parish (2023-2026). Other than his time in the USAF as an aircraft mechanic and later a chaplain, he has lived in Florida most of his life. He enjoys sports, especially watching the Miami Dolphins and Hurricanes.



WELCOME, FATHER SANTOW!

Fr. Santow John Kodamullil MSFS, hails from the state of Kerala, India, and serves in the Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales. He graduated from St. Xavier's College in Mapusa and completed his Bachelor of Arts degree and post graduation in History from Nagpur University. He was ordained a priest on May 3, 1993, after which he also got his Bachelor of Education. His first appointment was in St. Francis Xavier's High School in Siolim, as a teacher from June 1994 to May 1997.

He then served as the Principal of St. Joseph's High School in Kurla, Mumbai & Assistant Parish Priest of St. Joseph's Church until September 2002. He was then appointed as the Head Master of St. Francis Xavier's High School in Siolim. He was promoted to the Principal of St. Francis Xavier's Higher Secondary School in 2014. From June 2018 to April 2020, he served as the Assistant Parish Priest at St. Peter's Church in Gangapur City, and assisted at St. Francis de Sales Senior Secondary School in Gangapur City, Rajasthan. He retired from teaching on May 31, 2024. His aptitude, attributes and attitude towards life can be summarized into the following:

- 1. Love and concern for others:** Fr. Santow has many years of experience dealing with children, teachers, and parents. He has been working effectively with children of all ages, youth, young leaders and people from all walks of life. His qualities of gentleness, calmness, and patience make him approachable for people of all ages. He is a down to earth person.
- 2. Lover of books:** Fr. Santow is a voracious reader of English literature, stories, novels, historical books etc. Probably because of this, he is a master at English language - playing with words, writing and finding meaningful messages, and writing articles-books are his weakness!
- 3. Sportsman:** Fr. Santow is an enthusiastic sports person. Deprived of sports and game opportunities during his school days, he jumped at every opportunities that came his way later in life.
