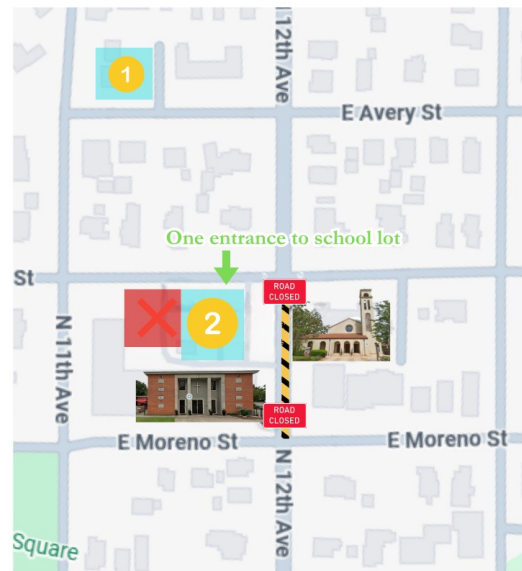

YOUTH MINISTRY: BLACKWATER RIVER TRIP



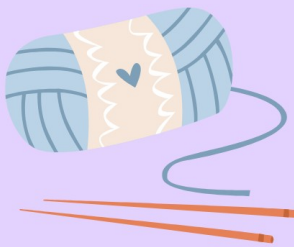

This welcoming group of women crochets and knits blessed items for anyone in need of comfort and healing.

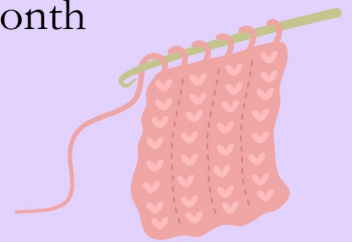
